

## 2026 TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- 1. The Event is open to all amateur golfers who are financial members of a golf club affiliated with Golf Australia. All entrants must have a current Golf Australia Handicap.
- 2. To be eligible for any prize, all entrants must have played at least 5 registered and handicapped golf events since 1<sup>st</sup> February 2025.
- 3. Entries only accepted with payment in full.
- Limited cart hire . Must be entered at booking with payment in full.
   Private Cart storage and charging requirements must be lodged at booking.
- 5. Electronic (MiScore) scoring is the sole official score for each event. It is the contestant's responsibility to have a compatible device.
- 6. The Rules of Golf and the local Rules of the venue club shall be the Rules of Play during the Tournament. Refer to the posted signage for any Temporary Local Rules
- 7. The Tournament Match Committee is the sole arbiter of any dispute or protest and reserves the right to vary any of the Conditions.
- 8. Draw every effort will be made to accommodate hit-off preferences without guarantees.

  Draws will be available on the Denmark Country Club website Friday 6th February 2026.
- 9. Competitors must report to the Official Starter at least 15 minutes before their tee time.
- 10. Time Limit Play for the 36 hole 4BBB will be in groups of 4 which are required to complete the round within 04hr 20min. Penalties may apply at the discretion of the Match Committee.
- 11. All ties will be decided by count-back per GA Rules.
- 12. There will be two events:
  - Classic Friday 13<sup>th</sup> February: 2 person Ambrose- Any Combination
  - Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> and Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> February: 36 Hole 4BBB Stableford, any combination
- 13. A player may win only ONE TROPHY per event. Novelties excepted
- 14. All efforts to contact winning players will be made but prizes must be collected, or collection arranged by recipients before the end of February 2026. Uncollected prizes will become the property of Denmark Country Club after 30 days.
- 15. No refunds will be available after Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> February 2026.
- 16. Daily Playing Handicap Limits apply, Max 36 for Men, Max 45 for Ladies.
- 17. For Both Events: Men Blue Tees, Ladies Red Tees



## 2026 Friday 2 Person Ambrose – Rules Supplement

- Electronic (MiScore) scoring is the sole official score for the event.
   It is the contestant's responsibility to have a compatible device.
- 2. Each player hits off their allocated tee. The tee farthest from the hole will play 1<sup>st</sup>.

**Note:** Each player needs to use at least six (6) tee shots for the day.

- 3. The best shot is selected and marked.
  - a. On the Fairway, players may pick up their ball and PLACE it, within 150mm of the best balls position.
     Either player may play 1st from this position.
  - b. <u>Off the Fairway</u>, the best ball is marked and must be played as it lies.
     The other player must **DROP** within 1 club length of the best balls position, no closer the hole.
     Either player may play 1st from this position.
- 4. The best shot is again selected, and so on until the green
- 5. On the putting green the best ball is marked and all balls are played within 1 putter head length.(100mm Nominal) no closer the hole. Either player may play 1st from this position.
- 6. This continues until the ball is in the hole.

## 7. FOR SPEED OF PLAY:

- a. Ready Golf is encouraged.
- b. Players may "finish out" with a max of 1 stroke, prior to their partner attempted their putt.
- c. Failure to finish out with the first attempt will void the partners chance at the lower score.
